What Is Ember?

Ember extends Ignite Reading instruction by giving students personalized reading practice before and after each tutoring session—up to 5 minutes each way.

Ember Activities

Activity	Description
Pop the Letters	Interactive letter identification for students still mastering letter-sound correspondence
Word Decoder	Personalized high-frequency and skill-gap word reading for students with decoding foundations
Word Transformer	Word modification changing one phoneme at a time

How It Works

Before Session	Student logs in 1–5 min early. Ember appears with personalized activities.
Tutoring	Normal 15-minute session. Ember pauses automatically.
After Session	Ember returns for up to 5 minutes of additional practice.

About the Technology

Ember uses:

- ✓ ASR to listen to students read
- ✓ Science of Reading aligned-curriculum

Ember does NOT use:

- ✗ Generative AI or LLMs (like ChatGPT)
- ✗ AI-generated instructional content
- ✗ Chatbots or conversational AI
