## **Why This Matters**

## **Preparation Steps**

Identify Your Champions:	
<ul> <li>Select a District Champion who will set the vision and goals for the implementation, overseeing Ignite Reading at the district level.</li> </ul>	
Select a School Champion who will help lead and coordinate Ignite Reading at each site.	
Plan ahead for access: Estimate how many student seats will be allocated to each school.	
Document schools and leaders for launch: Prepare your participating school and School Leader	· list.
Share the good news with Schools: Build excitement by sharing that Ignite Reading is coming.	
School sites choose their ideal session slots:	
☐ Sessions are 15 minutes, every weekday (M-F) on the quarter hour (:00, :15, :30, :45).	
☐ Please note at least two alternate time options in case your first choice isn't available.	
Think about who will benefit most: Start drafting a preliminary roster of students who may	
participate.	
Ensure every student's teacher is included: Prepare your teacher list for each participating scho	ol
site.	
Schedule time for training:	
☐ School sites allocate ~45 minutes for the School Leader and School Champion to comp	lete
Onboarding Training 3 weeks prior to launch.	
☐ School sites allocate ~1 hour for the School Leader and School Champion to complete	
School Staff Training 2-3 weeks prior to launch.
